Every morning you will walk into your Year 2 classroom through these doors.

There are two classrooms in Year 2, Birch Class and Willow Class.



You will say goodbye to your grown up at the door and put your coat and book bag on your own peg. The pegs will have your names on just like in Year 1. You will put your water bottle by the sink.

In Year 2 you will have a playtime in the morning. This is the same playground that you used when you were in Year 1.
