## **Transition into Year 1**

- Transition between Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum to National Curriculum
- Slide in' transition rather than 'Stop / Start' transition
- Lots is continuing from Year R e.g. daily phonics, exploring and learning time, daily maths, purposeful writing...
- Flexible transitioning into more formal learning later on in the Year, when the children are ready
- Exploring and Learning across the classrooms and in our shared areas.

### National Curriculum Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2)

- Core subjects: English, Maths, Science, Computing
- Foundation subjects: Art and Design, Design and Technology, Geography, History, Music, Physical Education.
- Statutory: Religious Education one week of every half term
- Discrete PE
- Exploring and Learning with continuous provision to provide opportunities to apply and embed directed teaching, inspire the children to learn independently and follow their own lines of enquiry across both classrooms and in our shared areas.

### Growth Mindset importance in Year 1

- Those with growth mindset make better progress in learning
- Fixed or Growth mindset
  - Fixed mindset intelligence fixed (can't be changed)
    - Unwilling to makes mistakes and always wants to be correct- stopping learning
    - I can't do it
  - Growth mindset ability can grow with practice
    - Always learning
    - Celebrate effort,
    - We learn from our mistakes
    - ▶ I can't do it <u>YET</u>



- Daily reading through phonics teaching
- Bug Club
- ▶ 5 x per week at home if possible
- Hearing stories, poetry and non-fiction with the teacher during Westgate Story Time
