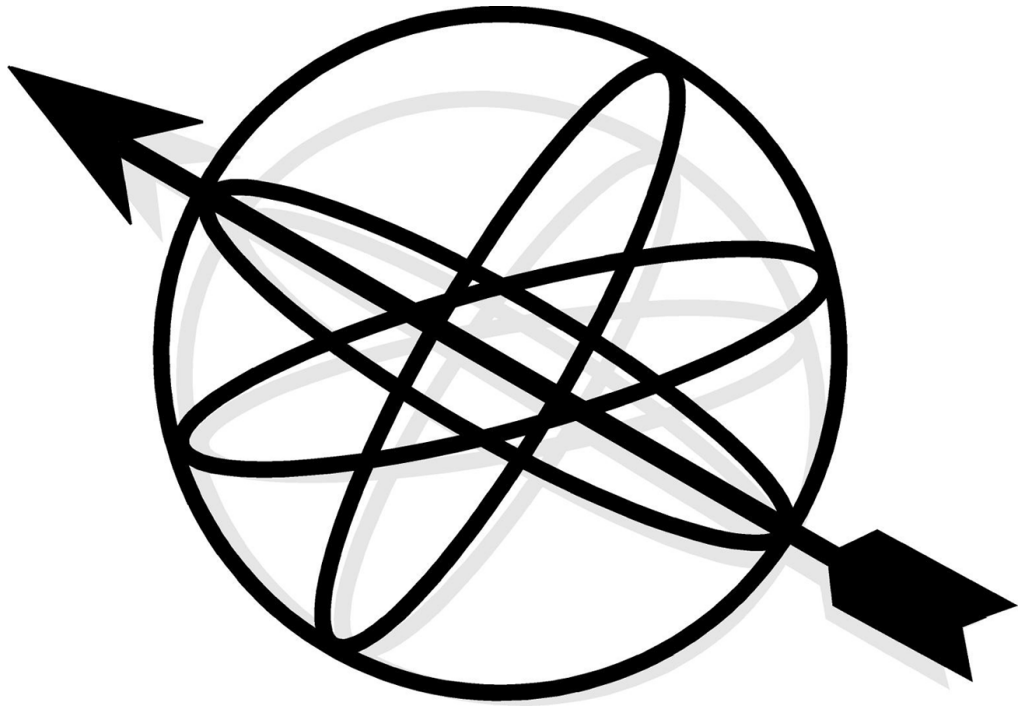


Welcome to Year 5 The Westgate Primary Phase

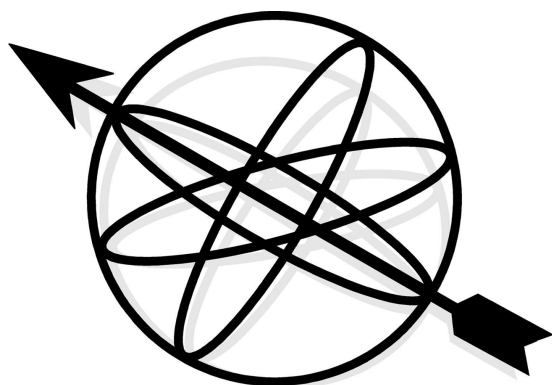


Information for Parents and Carers

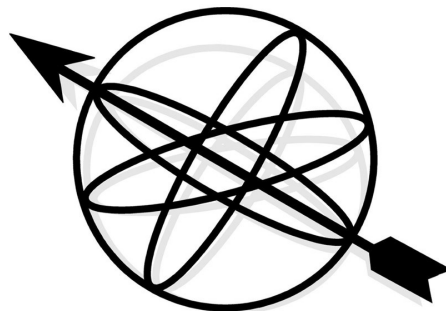
