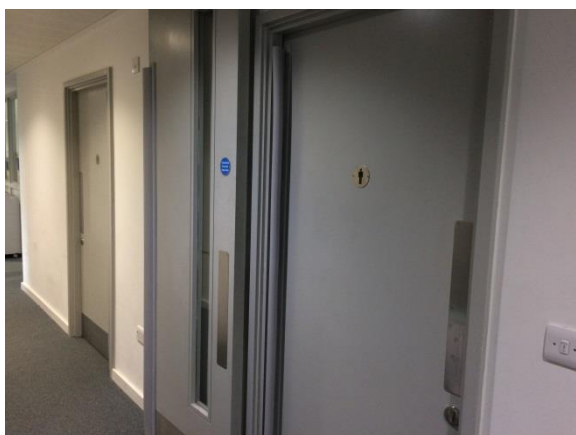
I will walk into school through these doors.
